The Saugerties Farmers Market welcomes locally grown/raised food and gives preference to the use of local ingredients in locally produced food products.

Attendance

If you are not able to attend the market on a date you have signed up for on your application, please advise the Market Manager at least one week in advance. We need to plan for each market day. THANK YOU IN ADVANCE FOR THIS CONSIDERATION. There are no refunds for dates you do not attend, unless you inform the Market Manager one week in advance and we fill your space with a fee-payer.

Equipment & Space

We will provide you with one table (6' long) and folding chairs. Please be prepared to bring with you each market day:

- Tablecloth
- Bags
- Change and a safe box to keep your money
- Broom and other suitable equipment to clean your area before you leave
- Attractive sign with your farm/business name & location (town)
- Price signs per product

Space Assignment

You will have room for one table of 6' length. There is no wall space on which to hang items. Everything will have to fit on the table. If you need more space, please request a second space and make sure that the Market Manager has 2 spaces available for you.

Please see the Market Manager on market day for your space assignment. We will be there to assist you. If you need to reach someone on the market day: Ann Krupp is reachable at cell 845-863-5381 (day of market only).

Set-up

Please come between 10:30-11am. You will need the time, as there are many of you and limited entry space. Pull your vehicle into the parking lot to offload. Use any of the 3 entry doors that are convenient to your space.

Parking

Do **NOT** park in the parking lot, as we want to save the lot for customers. After unloading, please park on the next street north, Moser Drive, which is an entry drive to the recreational fields next door.

Assistance

If you need help with set-up, breakdown, or to retrieve items from your vehicle during the market, please ask for help from a committee person (there should be a number of us around identified by nametags). Or, if you need a short relief, we might fill in for you.

Break-down

Please do **NOT** start to break down before 4pm. We received a complaint from a customer who said she was disappointed that people were already putting things away before the end of the market. Those customers who come at the end need to be treated with the same courtesy as those at the beginning.

Garbage Removal

You need to take away your trash with you for proper disposal. You are responsible for removing everything you came with. You must take any recyclable bottles with you.

Clean-up

Please clean your area after the end of the market day with your own broom. If you have forgotten it, the Market Manager has one to loan. Please leave your area as you found it. This is a Senior Citizen Center and has constant use during the week. If we do not treat the building with respect, we will not get the use of it in the future.

Bad Weather

The market goes on rain, snow or shine. However, if there is a very serious storm, we will make the determination the night before or that morning. We will try to call you. Please also take the responsibility to look on our website (www.SaugertiesFarmersMarket.com) where we will post a notice.

- **FROM THE SOUTH:** Take the New York State Thruway (87) to Exit 20. Make a right turn onto Route 212, which also becomes Ulster Avenue over the railroad tracks; go straight for 0.9 miles until the road goes either left or right. Make a left turn and go straight for 0.5 miles through a residential area and then you will come to a large parking lot and a one story gray building on the right which is the Greco Memorial Senior Citizen Center.
- **FROM THE NORTH:** Take the New York State Thruway (87) to Exit 20. Get off the exit and make a left turn onto Route 32 for 0.2 miles to traffic light, make a left turn onto Route 212 and follow the directions above.
- **FROM THE WEST:** Take Route 212 to the Village of Saugerties and follow the directions above.
- **FROM THE EAST:** From the Kingston/Rhinecliff Bridge take the first exit off the bridge to Saugerties via Route 32 north. Proceed through the Village of Saugerties, turning left at the traffic signal onto Main Street, then right at the next signal onto Market Street. Continue straight at the third signal and proceed as above to the Senior Center.
